

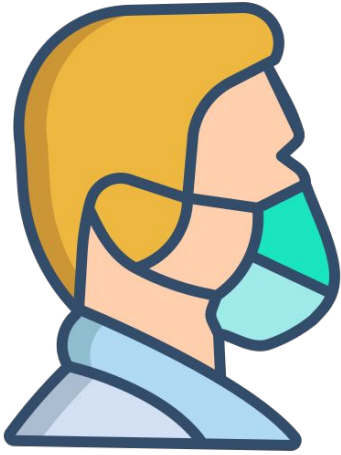

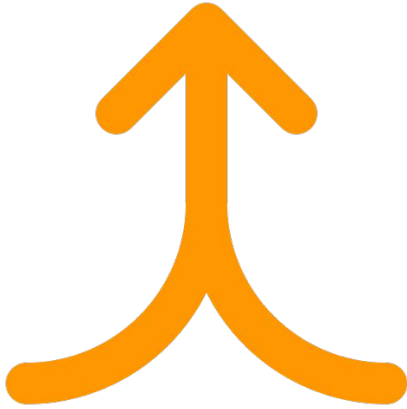




MLSD Covid Cases
