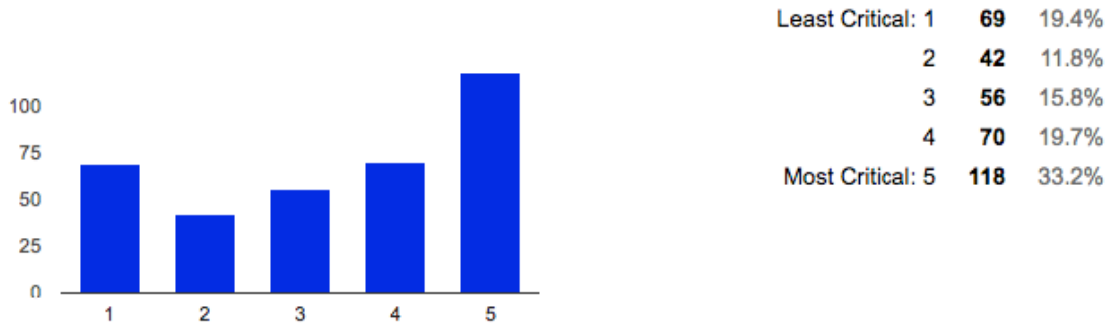

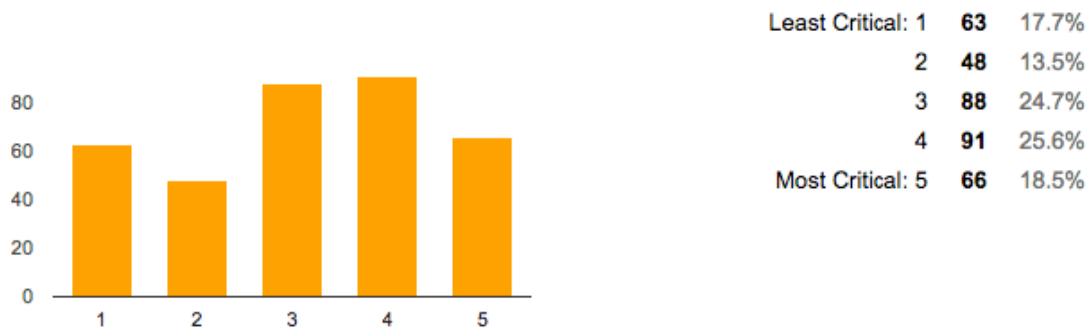
## Summary

### Proposed Question 1

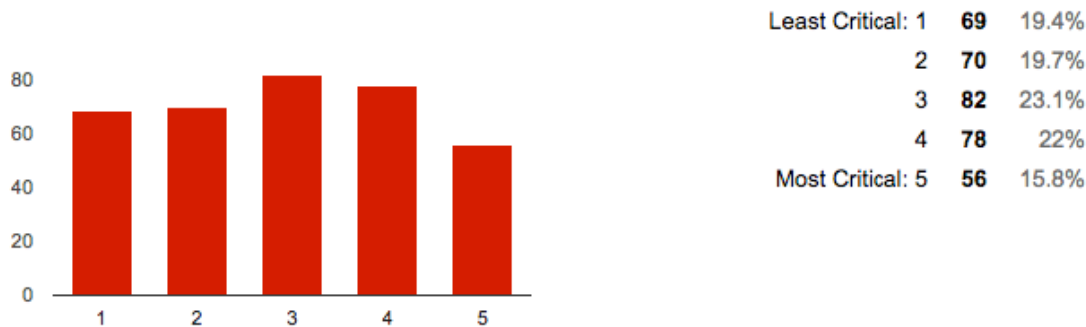
**Wildwood Safety and Security.** This improvement would provide for shatterproof windows for all classrooms on the wheel, security doors for all exterior doors on the wheel, and a renovated main office with a security vestibule that will keep visitors separate from the school population until a security check is complete.



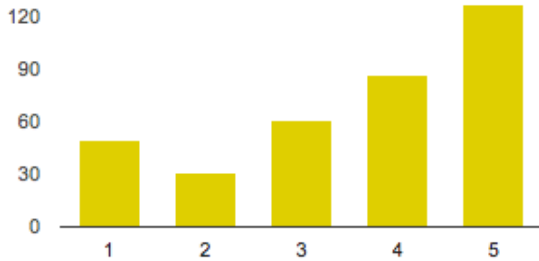
**Wildwood Cafeteria and Kitchen Expansion.** This improvement would allow for lunch to be offered to students at more reasonable times in a less crowded and rushed environment. In addition, there would be greater flexibility in the master schedule. The renovated cafeteria could serve multiple uses during non-lunch periods.



**Wildwood Bathroom Renovations.** This improvement would modernize the four original, 1965 boys' and girls' bathrooms on the upper and lower levels.

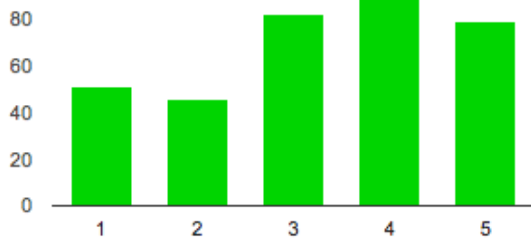


**Briarcliff Safety and Security.** This improvement would move the main office to the front of the building with a direct sightline to all activity in the front of the building and provide a renovated main office with a security vestibule that will keep visitors separate from the school population until a security check is complete.



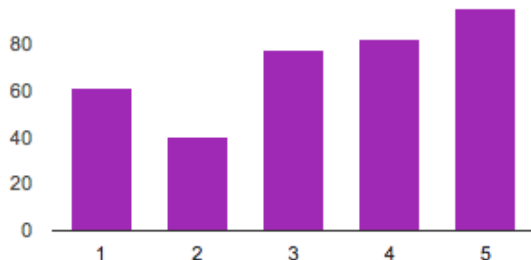

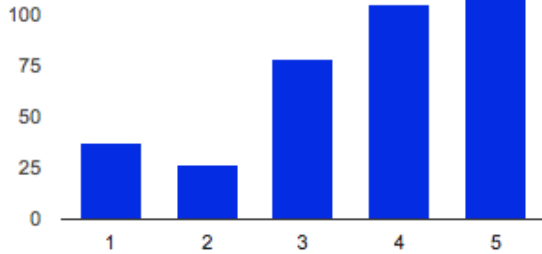

**Renovation of the Briarcliff Boy's and Girl's Locker Rooms and Gymnasium.** This renovation would provide space for a Band Room in the existing Boy's Locker Room and modernize the Gym with air conditioning, a new ceiling, stage lift and lighting.



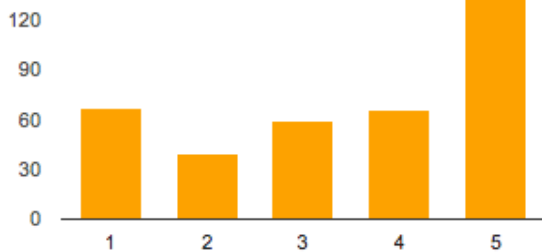

**Creation of a 6th Grade Science Lab and school-wide Maker Space at Briarcliff.** Some of the cost of these projects are being offset by donations from the Mountain Lakes Education Foundation and fundraising. These projects would modernize and double the size of the existing 6th Grade Science Lab. The Maker Space would provide opportunities for all students to study and design Robots, Circuits, and 3D Models. In addition, students would learn and test computer coding sequences.



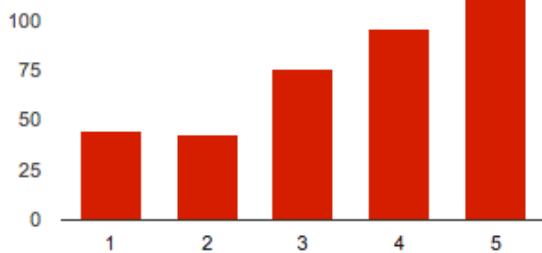

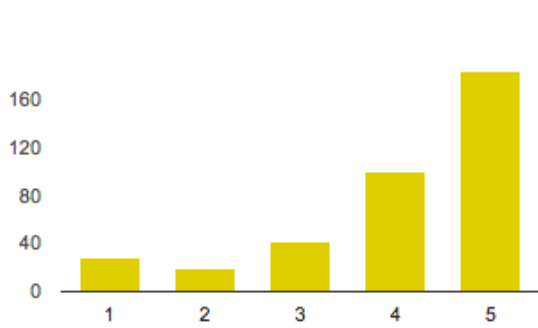

The renovated cafeteria could serve multiple uses during non-lunch periods.



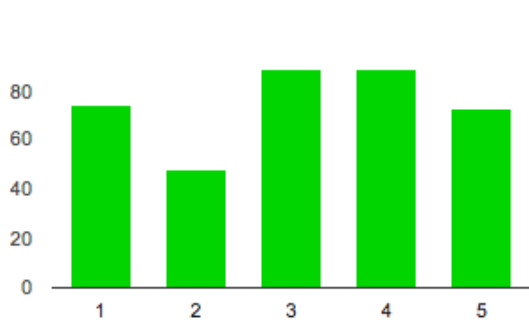

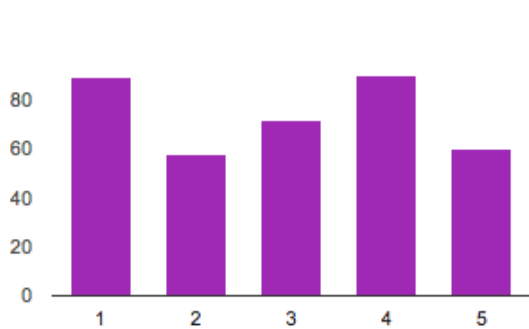

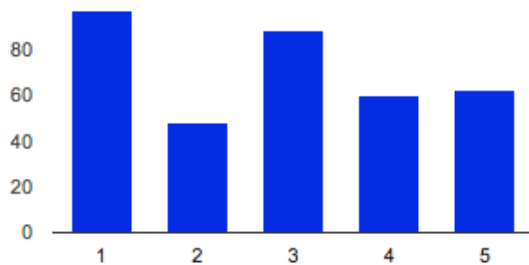

## Proposed Question 2

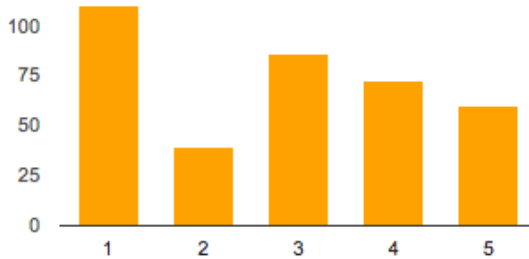

## Proposed Question 3

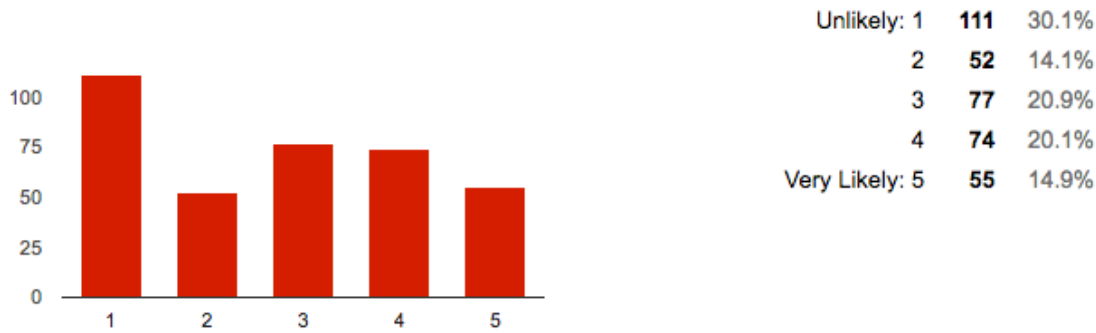
